Savage graduated from Dubuque Senior High School, received a Bachelor's Degree from Loras College in Spanish and Secondary Teaching then completed two Masters degrees at Loras in Effective Teaching and Educational Admin. She will complete her doctorate in K-12 Organizational Leadership through Grand Canyon University in August 2016.

She was a world language teacher at Western Dubuque

Community Schools in Dyersville and Hempstead High School in Dubuque from 1995-2009, along with serving as an adjunct professor at Northeast Iowa Community College in Peosta and University of Dubuque. In 2009, Savage became a principal in the Williams Unified Schools in Williams, Arizona where she was promoted to superintendent in 2012.

"We are thrilled to have Rachel join our Waterloo administrative staff. Her experiences in Iowa and Arizona will be invaluable to moving our district forward. She brings a passion for teaching and learning as well as strong leadership skills," said Dr. Jane Lindaman, Waterloo Schools superintendent.

Savage replaces Andy Mische who becomes the new West High School principal July 1.

Evansdale Spring Clean Up

Evansdale News The Evansdale Spring cleanup is scheduled for Friday May 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday May 2nd from 7:30 a.m. to noon. Residents are requested to bring items to the Street Department Garage at 130 Brown Street, one block north of Lafayette Rd., next to the recycling bins.

We will NOT accept regular household trash, tires, concrete, rocks, batteries, hazardous waste, liquids, any type of yard waste, or large quantities of building materials. Separate any metal items from the rest, as metals are recycled rather than taken to the landfill.

This service is only available to Evansdale residents. When you arrive at the Street Department, you will be required to present your driver's license showing your Evansdale address.

If you are elderly or have a hardship preventing you from bringing the items to the Street Department, call us at the City Hall Business Office and we will attempt to find a resource to assist you in hauling.

If you wish to dispose of appliances during Spring Clean-up, please purchase a sticker at the City Hall Business Office. Office hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The deadline to purchase a sticker is Friday, May 1st at 4:30 p.m.

The sticker cost is \$12 for each appliance to be dropped off at the Street Department. The sticker charge is \$25 to have the appliance picked up curbside on May 1st.
