Evansdale Spring Clean Up Set for May

Evansdale News The Evansdale Spring cleanup is scheduled for Friday May 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday May 2nd from 7:30 a.m. to noon. Residents are requested to bring items to the Street Department Garage at 130 Brown Street, one block north of Lafayette Rd., next to the recycling bins.

We will NOT accept regular household trash, tires, concrete, rocks, batteries, hazardous waste, liquids, any type of yard waste, or large quantities of building materials. Separate any metal items from the rest, as metals are recycled rather than taken to the landfill.

This service is only available to Evansdale residents. When you arrive at the Street Department, you will be required to present your driver's license showing your Evansdale address.

If you are elderly or have a hardship preventing you from bringing the items to the Street Department, call us at the City Hall Business Office and we will attempt to find a resource to assist you in hauling.

If you wish to dispose of appliances during Spring Clean-up, please purchase a sticker at the City Hall Business Office. Office hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The deadline to purchase a sticker is Friday, May 1st at 4:30 p.m.

The sticker cost is \$12 for each appliance to be dropped off at the Street Department. The sticker charge is \$25 to have the appliance picked up curbside on May 1st.

The following appliances will be accepted: Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Dishwashers, Dryers, Freezers, Microwaves, Refrigerators, Stoves, Thermostats, Washers, Water heaters, Capacitor-start electric motor, Electrical and Electronic Devices. Water softeners will not be accepted.

Items will not be accepted after hours under any circumstance. Anyone who drops items at the gate before or after hours will be fined for illegal dumping.



Electronics and Hazardous Materials Drop-off Event


Press Release The Black Hawk County Solid Waste Management Commission will be partnering with the City of Waterloo to sponsor an electronics recycling event and household hazardous materials drop-off. ALL Black Hawk County residents are welcome to bring approved household toxic materials and electronics (fees may apply). The drop-off will be held on Saturday, April 11th from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. at the Waterloo Waste Water Treatment Plant, located at 3505 Easton Ave. The event is set-up as a large drivethrough, with a crew of over 40 volunteers donating their time to help unload the materials. Volunteers (18 and older) are still needed to make the lines move fast- call the Waste Trac Education Team (266-8722) to sign up! Both light weight and heavy lifting volunteer duties

At the event the Black Hawk

County Solid Waste Management Commission will be accepting toxic materials from county resident homes for free at the drop-off event. Items such as lawn chemicals, rechargeable batteries, fluorescent light bulbs (compact and tube), propane tanks, old gasoline, mercury thermometers, and much more will be accepted for safe disposal. A list of accepted items can be found at WasteTrac.org or call 266-8722.

The Black Hawk County Solid Waste Management Commission will also be sponsoring an Electronics Recycling Dropoff. Each vehicle/household bringing items to the event can recycle two CRT (non flatscreen) monitors/televisions for free. Additional CRTs are \$5 each (with no limit). All hard drives will be shredded by Mid-

Residents are asked to bring exact cash only. Bills larger than \$20 will not be accepted. Appliances (such as microwaves, stoves, dehumidifiers, washers, dryers, refrigerators) WILL NOT be accepted at the event.

The following items WILL NOT be accepted at the event: paint, appliances, tires, motor oil, antifreeze, ammunition, fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, asbestos, radioactive materials, or non-hazardous waste. To dispose of appliances or large bulk items, please call your city public works office, neighborhood association, or the Black Hawk County Landfill (296-2524).
