Authorities Ask for Information Regarding the Disappearance of Lyric and Elizabeth and Seven Bridges

Evansdale News On Tuesday, February 3, 2015, local police held a conference regarding the disappearance of Elizabeth Collins and Lyric Cook. Evansdale Police and Iowa Division

of Criminal Investigation officials spent two days at the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children headquarters, for a case review with experts from across the country.

Based on that discussion, local authorities have decided to focus on the importance of the Seven Bridges Wildlife Area in Bremer County. If you have any information regarding this

area, or know someone who is familiar with the area and was acting suspicious in July of 2012, authorities are asking you to call the Evansdale Police tipline number listed below.

Press Release Waterloo Schools will co-host a FIRST Tech Challenge League Qualifier with Cedar Falls on Saturday, February 7th at Central Middle School.

The event will run from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. with matches in play from 11:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) is designed for students in grades 7 through 12 to compete head-to-head using a sports model. Teams are responsible for designing, building and programming their robots to compete in an alliance format against other teams. Teams including coaches, mentors and

volunteers are required to develop strategy and build robots based on sound engineering principles. Awards are given for the competition as well as for community outreach, design and other real-world accomplishments.

Over 24 teams from eastern Iowa will attend. To learn more about the team from Bunger Middle School, check out the Waterloo Schools web page and view the video.

Five teams will advance from the tournament to the state tournament March 6th and 7th in Coralville. The event is free and open to the public.
