Submitted Terry Bogardus was recently diagnosed with stage 3 larynx cancer. Due to this diagnosis, he will undergo chemotherapy and radiation. Terry will be in Iowa City 5 days a week for 7 weeks. His wife will be with him during these treatments, so she will be unable to work much. They have 3 children, so the family will need all the help they can get. All money raised will be used for gas and food while traveling to treatment, unpaid medical expenses, bills, and caring for their children.

A benefit has been scheduled to help raise this money. The benefit will be held on Saturday, January 24th, from 4 to 10 p.m. at Lofty's Lounge in Evansdale.

The cost will be \$10 for a plate,

Bullous Emphysema causes the spherical air sacs in the lungs to become severely enlarged and eventually rupture and deteriorate. Severe cases can cause one or both lungs to collapse.

Friends and family are preparing a benefit to help him focus on his fight. The benefit will be held on Saturday, January 17 from 4 to 10 p.m. at Lofty's Lounge, in Evansdale. There will be food, a silent auction, raffles, and live music by the local band Urban Legend.
