From the Mayor's Office Regarding Road Construction this Summer

Submitted By Doug Faas, Mayor of Evansdale. The city of Evansdale will work on repairs to the Dubuque Road bridges this summer. Beginning on or about June 15th, the eastbound lanes of Dubuque Road will be closed for approximately one month. When repairs are completed to the eastbound bridge and the lanes are reopened, repairs will commence on the

westbound bridge which will then make it necessary to close the westbound lanes for approximately one month. The detour for the entire construction process will be Evans to Lafayette to Gilbertville Road in Elk Run Heights. Signs will also be posted designating the detour. Thank you in advance for your patience during this needed infrastructure repair.

The name of the person on the application for the exemption must be the same as the person who signed the contract with the Evansdale Water Works for water, sewer and garbage services.
