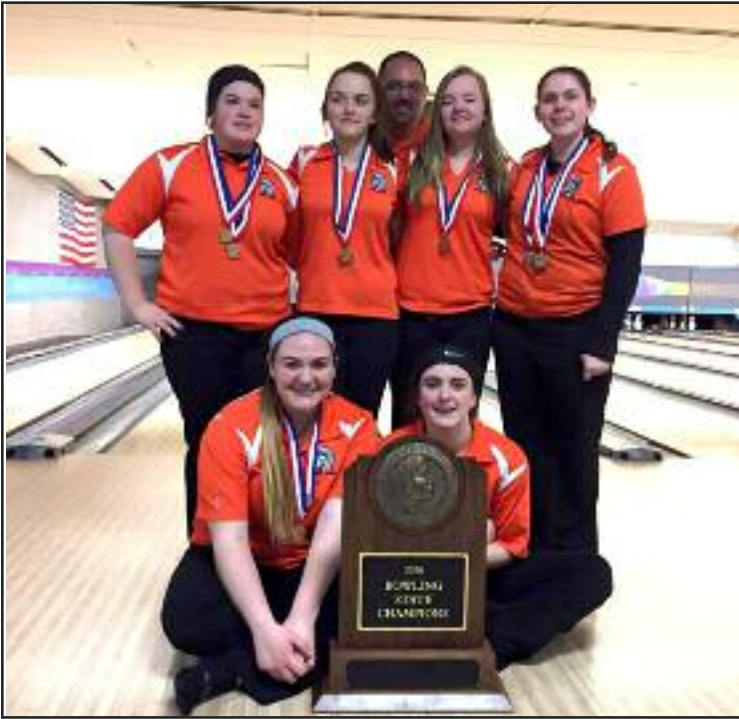

East High Trojans recorded three of the top four individual scores and put together their 2nd best baker round of the season to clinch the Iowa High School State 2A Championship with a total of 3,071 pins. It was a score that was 208 pins better than runner-up Ottumwa, and 45 pins better than Tuesday's 2A boys' champion Urbandale.

Leah Frost took home the individual state title with her career-high, two-game set of 500,

with 15 consecutive strikes after her first-frame spare for a 290 game and a strong start to her second game of 210. East filled the leaderboard with junior Alissa Claassen placing third (234-195—429) and senior Josie Jacobs fourth (180-245—425). Trojan freshmen Alysha Edler (372) and Ashlee Snapp (340) also counted toward the team total, while senior Ashley Cary stepped up during the baker round to solidify the win. Great team effort! 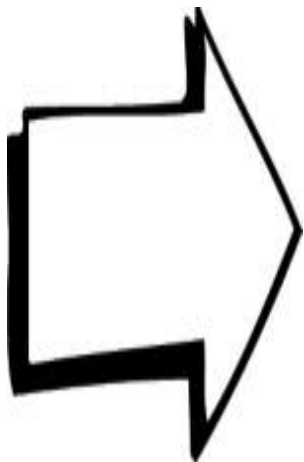
