Is This Evansdale's Largest Sweet Potato?

Evansdale News Bailey Hollaway, a 5th grade student at Poyner Elementary, helped his grandfather, Jerry Harms, plant the sweet potatoes in the spring, and has been helping water and weed the garden since. When they dug up their harvest, they were surprised to find such big potatoes. The biggest weighs almost 3.5 pounds!



According to the Guinness Book of World Records website, the world's heaviest sweet potato weighed 81 pounds and 9 ounces on 8 March 2004 and was grown by Manuel Pérez in Güime, Lanzarote, Spain.
