## “Coaches Classic” Brings Over 100 Coaches Together

*Press Release* Recently over one hundred paid and volunteer coaches for Waterloo Schools athletics met for the Coaches Classic. The annual event celebrates the key role these individuals play in heading up some 20 athletic teams in the district during fall, winter, spring and summer sports.

This year two speakers, a sports psychologist and representative from the Iowa High School Athletic Association, spoke to the crowd to address everything from getting the most out of student athletes to handling safety and legal issues.

Bringing the coaches together reinforces the partnership between the district and community, in terms of athletic program continuity. Longtime Bunger Middle School wrestling coach, Randi Finger, also runs the 7-year-old Evansdale Wrestling Club. “I get close with my wrestlers. I watch them go through school and try to be a good role model for them.”

Thanks to coaches like Finger, the foundation is being laid at the elementary level for middle and high school programs in the Waterloo school district.
